

PRINT TEST:

1. Before printing, ensure that page scaling or fit to page is OFF.
2. After printing, measure the bar at right, it should measure exactly 2 inches long.
3. If measurement is not 2 inches, check again that you are printing at full size and reprint.



RING SIZER:

1. Choose a ring that fits your finger (or the finger of the person you're giving the ring to)
2. Place the ring over the circles at the right. The inside of the ring should match the outline of the circle that is closest in size. Make sure that you can see the entire outline of the circle, but no gaps, for the best match.
3. The measurement is the diameter of the ring and is shown in millimeters. You can also measure the diameter of the ring at the widest part and compare measurements to size.

STRING SIZER:

1. Cut a thick string, preferably yarn, to about 3 inches.
2. Wrap the string snugly, but not tightly, around your finger.
3. Mark the join spot (where the ends of the string meet around your finger) and measure that length with a ruler that has millimeters (inches are not accurate enough).
4. Note that measurement then tie a knot in the string and put it on your finger. Make sure that it goes over your knuckle without stretching and fits snugly around your finger.
5. If it does not fit over your knuckle, remeasure at the widest point of your knuckle and use that measurement.

PAPER SIZER:

1. I recommend using this only if ordering a thick or wide band ring. Wide band rings fit slightly smaller and this paper band should be considered wide.
2. Cut out sizer along outline and make a small cut exactly along the dotted slit line.
3. Wrap around your finger with numbers facing out and slide the pointed end of the sizer through the slit.
4. Pull the sizer snugly at the widest part of your finger. The number that lines up with the slit represents your approximate ring size.

PAPER SIZER
